

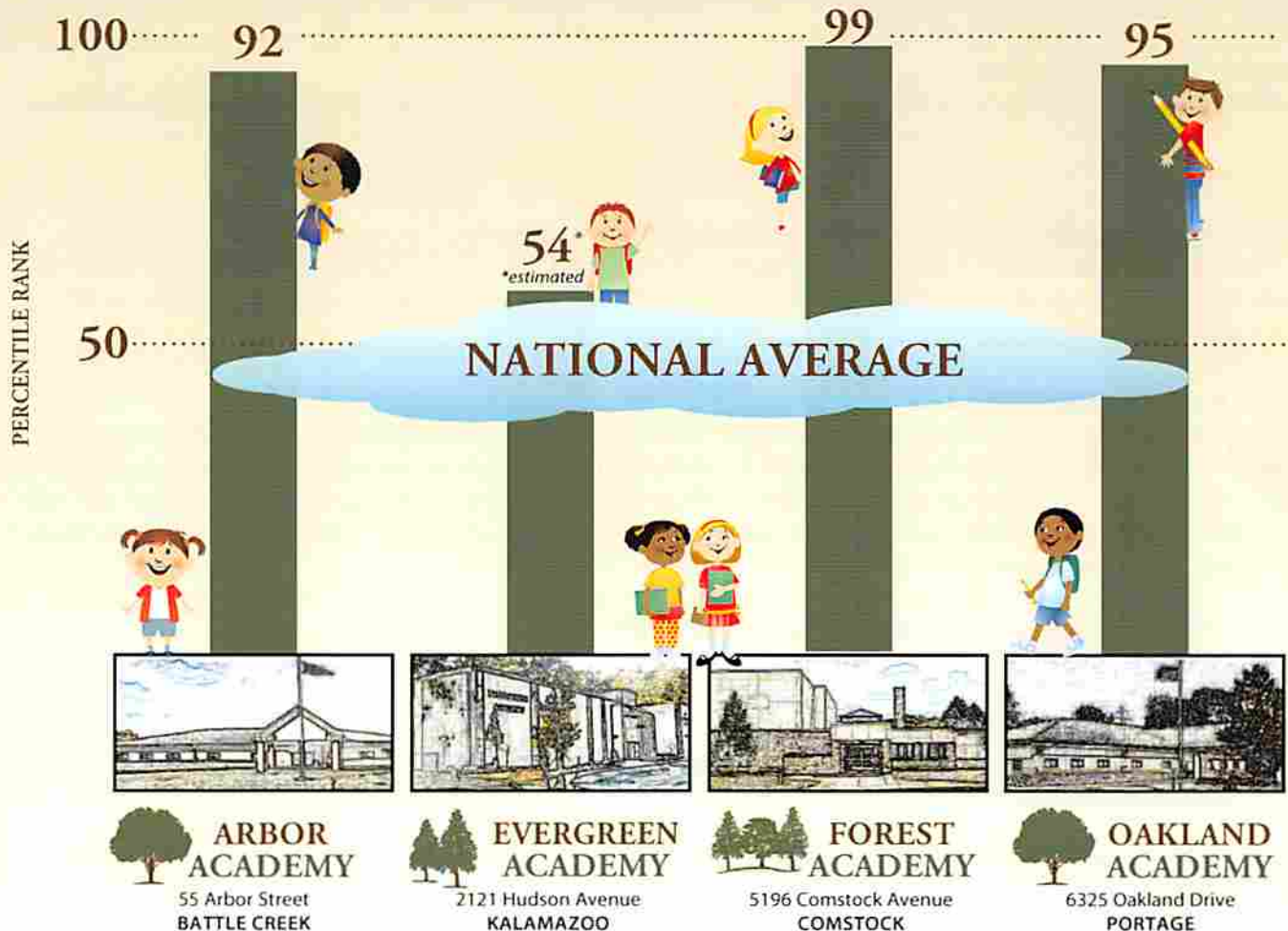

We use a carefully planned curriculum

We know that to accomplish any important goal, there must be a detailed and complete plan, or blueprint, to guide our efforts. The Academies have developed a plan over the last 20 years through our program of instruction and research on early childhood learning.

Double the teaching staff

We provide a certified teacher for each 10 children to make certain that every child is assured constant opportunities for learning guidance.
